ENROLMENT

The course is run on a two semester system. Semester one begins in February and Semester two in August. However as the course is largely self paced students are able to begin the course during the semester and then fit in with the block courses.

BLOCK COURSES

Block courses are currently run twice each semester with a duration of 1-2 days per block course. They are located according to requirements.

COURSE FEES

The cost per module is \$1500+gst. Contact LTG for discount options. **In addition**, students are required to become members of the local Chartered Institute of Logistics & Transport (CILT) eg Cilt (NZ). Registration and Assessment fees are also payable by the student upon submission of assignments to the UK for marking.



WHO SHOULD STUDY THE DIPLOMA?

METHOD OF STUDY

A combination of self-paced learning, electronically submitted assignments, and face-to-face teaching (via block courses which are advised though not compulsory) means that students can study part time while they are working, even from offshore locations e.g. military postings.

Assessments will include regular assignments, a business plan development and preparation of reports, all submitted electronically.
